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TERM AND CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF DRUGS & MEDICAL CONSUMABLES TO Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack ON RATE CONTRACT BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY.

- 1.1 Sealed tenders for the purchase of Drugs & Medical Consumables will be received in the office of the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack, within 5.00 P.M of dt. 22.08.2025. Any tender received after the due date and time will be rejected and returned unopened to the sender. The Tenders will be received only through Regd. Post / Courier Service / Speed Post.
- 1.2 Pre-bid conference shall be held in the office chamber of Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack on dt. 28.07.2025 at 03.00 P.M. The prospective bidders may attend and raise any doubts on the term and conditions of the bid document. (**Only one authorized person is allowed to attend the meeting for each firm with authorization letter from the firm specially authorized to attend the said meeting**)
- 1.3 The sealed tender 'Cover A' (Technical Bid) submitted by the tenderer will be opened by the Purchase Committee at the Office of the Medical Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack at **05.00 P.M. on Dt. 25.08.2025**. The tenderers or their duly authorized representative is allowed to be present during the opening of the tenders if they so like. (**Only one authorized person is allowed to attend the meeting for each firm with authorization letter from the firm specially authorized to attend the said meeting**).
- 1.4 If any changes to the terms & condition & date & time will be notified in website only.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

- 2.1 Tenderers shall be a manufacturer having valid up-to-date manufacturing License with drug endorsement copy, Trade License issued by competent authority for Corporate Office as well as Local Branch Office/ Authorised distributor (Govt. of Odisha) registered under OGST Act, Valid ISO Certificate, Valid GMP certificate or WHO-GMP certificate (applicable for drugs), Valid CE certificate of the manufacturer (applicable for medical consumables), Non-Conviction Certificate (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)), Minimum 5 years of valid Market Standing Certificate, PAN card, Last 5 financial years IT return (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24), GST Registration Certificate, GSTR 3B on monthly basis for one year (F.Y-2024-25) can participate in the process.
- 2.2 Distributor can participate in the bidding process. If so, he/she has to submit Notarized Xerox copy of Valid Drug License, ISO Certificate, Registration Certificate (Commercial Establishment) under Directorate of Labour, Odisha issued by the Inspector of Shops & Commercial Establishment, Trade License issued by competent authority for Corporate Office as well as Local Branch Office (Govt. of Odisha), registered under OGST act Valid up-to-date. Non-conviction Certificate of his/her own firm (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)), PAN card, Last 5 financial years IT return (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24), GST Registration Certificate, GSTR 3B on monthly basis for one year (2024-25).



- 2.3 The Annual Turnover of the Manufacturer should be Rs.10Crore or more for each financial year during last five financial years(2019-20,2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24)duly certified by the Chartered Accountant as per the prescribed format (Annexure -VII)(**Not applicable for SSI Units registered under Govt. of Odisha**).If the tenderer is a distributor, he/she has to submit the Annual Turnover statement of Rs.10 Crore or morefor each financial year (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24)with annual audited statement / Annual Report of his/her firm in prescribed format.(**Provisional Statement of account shall not be considered**).
- 2.4 Tenderer/manufacturing unit which has been blacklisted for any item either by the Tender inviting authority or by any State Govt. or Central Govt. Organization cannot participate in the Tender for that item during the period of blacklisting supporting to court affidavit (Annexure- I).
- 2.5 The Tenderer (Manufacturer/ Distributer) should have typically not less than5 (five) years of marketing experience in Medicine/ Pharmaceuticals products supplying to the Government Organization/ PSU Hospital in India (Annexure-VII).
- 2.6 Any bidder who has been convicted by a competent Authorities/ court of law for supplying (NSQ/ Spurious/ Adulterated/ Misbranded etc.) drugs within a period of last 3 years from the date of floating of tender shall not be eligible to participate in the tender.

2.7 Note:-

- A. **"Tenderer"** means the Manufacturer/Distributerparticipating in this tender.
- B. Valid up-to-date means the certificate should be valid on the date of opening of Tender (Cover-A) as per Tender conditions. In case the validity of GMP / manufacturing license has expired within six months on the date of opening of tender and the firm / tenderer has applied for renewal of the same, a letter from the competent authority with copy of treasury challan has to be attached alongwith the tender submitted mentioning that the Retentionis under process/ consideration as per D & C Act.

Sealed cover containing the tender in the prescribed form should be submitted in two sealed covers, Cover "A" (Technical Bid) & Cover "B"(Price Bid) as indicated below. - 3.1 Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 8,00,000/- (Eight Lakh Rupees) only in shape of Demand Draft from any Nationalized /Scheduled Bankdrawn in favour Superintendent, **SCB MCH, Cuttack** payable at Cuttack.
- 3.2 Checklist with detail of the documents enclosed in Cover 'A'. The documents should be serially arranged, numbered (from bottom to top) as per this format and should be securely tied or bound.
- 3.3 Particulars of the tenderer (Company, Firm and Individual) and its authorized representative (Director/Managing Partner/Proprietor)/distributor like; name, address, telephone no., mobile no., fax, e-mail, GSTIN etc. (Annexure-IV)
- 3.4 Trade License issued by competent Authority for Corporate Office as well as Local Branch Office (Govt. of Odisha) along with address, Telephone No., mobile No., e-mail, Fax of the Branch Office /Contact Person in Odisha. (Annexure-IV).



- 3.5 Registration Certificate (Commercial Establishment) under Directorate of Labour, Odisha issued by the Inspector of Shops & Commercial Establishment for distributor.
- 3.6 List of items quoted with strength / specification and packing.(Annexure-III)
- 3.7 Valid up-to-date Manufacturing License with drug endorsement (i.e. the list of approved items issued at the time of grant / renewal of the license and it should be a single list) of the items quoted / copy of import license if items quoted are imported /copy of BIS certificate wherever applicable. If the validity of license has expired within six months on the date of bid opening, then letter from the competent authority with copy of treasury challan is to be attached alongwith the tender submitted mentioning that the tenderer has applied for Retention of license.
 - 3.7.1 In case of manufacturer, the copy of the valid manufacturing license issued by the drug controlling authority with drug endorsement of each item quoted, has to be submitted along with the tender.
 - 3.7.2 In case of importers, copy of the Import license certificate issued by Drugs Controller General of India, New Delhi will have to be submitted by the tenderer. The importer shall also have to submit the **Authorization certificate from the manufacturer** to deal business in India.
- 3.8 Valid up-to-date Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) certificate of the manufacturer as per the revised Schedule M of Drugs & Cosmetics Act 1940 / WHO GMP certificate from the licensing authority (In case of Drugs Only).
- 3.9 Non-conviction Certificate (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)) mentioning that, the firm has not been convicted under the provision of D&C Act 1940 by any court of law in contravention to the above Act & Rules & has not been blacklisted for any item either by the tender inviting authority or by any state Govt. or Central Government.
- 3.10 Valid Market Standing Certificate from the competent authority that, the manufacturer/firm typically not less than 5 (five) years of manufacturing & marketing experience in Medicine/ Pharmaceuticals products supplying to the Government Organization/PSU Hospital in India.
- 3.11 Certificate duly filled by the Auditor / Chartered Accountant that the Annual Turnover of Manufacturer is Rs.10crore or more for each financial year preceding 5 (five) financial years i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 (Annexure-VI) **(Not applicable for SSI Units registered under Govt. of Odisha)**. If the tenderer is a distributor, he/she has to submit the Annual Turnover statement of Rs.10Crore or more for each financial year(2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24)in prescribed format with annual audited statement / Annual Report duly filled by the Chartered Accountant.
- 3.12 The Tenderer (Manufacturer/ Distributer) should have typically not less than 5 (five) years of marketing experience in Medicine/ pharmaceuticals products supplying to the Government Organization/ PSU Hospitals in India duly supported documentary evidence ((5 (five) no's of Purchase Order copies for each financial year duly attested by Notary Public) from minimum 5 (five) competent Authorities & End User Certificate from same 5 (five) competent authorities for last five year i.e. (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) (Performance Statement (Annexure-VII).



- 3.13 The Tenderer has to submit Affidavit in respect to not been convicted under the provision of D&C Act 1940 by any court of law in contravention to the above Act & Rules & has not been blacklisted for any item either by the tender inviting authority or by any state Govt. or Central Govt. Organization participate in the tender for that item during the period of blacklisting. (Annexure- I)
- 3.14 The Tender Book duly signed and sealed by the competent person/bidder in each page (Full signature of competent person of the firm with mercantile seal).
- 3.15 Valid & up-to-date ISO Certificate of the Manufacturer.
- 3.16 Valid CE certificate of the manufacturer (applicable for medical consumables).
- 3.17 If the tenderer is a distributor, he/she has to submit Valid Drug license, ISO Certificate, GST Registration Certificate, Registration Certificate (Commercial Establishment) under Directorate of Labour, Odisha issued by the Inspector of Shops & Commercial Establishment, Trade License issued by competent Authority for Corporate Office as well as Local Branch Office (Govt. of Odisha), Non-conviction Certificate (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)), GSTR 3B & GSTR-1 on monthly basis for last one year (2023-24), PAN Card, Last 5 financial years IT return (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24), Annual Turnover statement for last 5 financial year with annual audited statement / Annual Report duly certified by Chartered Accountant of his/her firm/agency.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED IN PRICE BID (COVER- 'B'):

- 4.1 The rates offered or quoted by the tenderer for various drugs & medical consumables (item-wise) should be submitted in a separate sealed cover hereafter-called Cover 'B' (Price Bid). The lists of items with specifications for which tenders are invited are in Annexure – II.
- 4.2 The Price Bid (price schedule) in the prescribed form (as per Format) should be submitted inclusive of excise duty, insurance, packing, forwarding and freight (except SSI units registered under OSIC & NSIC (i.e. door delivery) but exclusive of GST. The rate should be quoted for each tablet / capsule / vial / ampoule / bottle / tube etc. i.e. only absolute rate (both in figures and words). But supply will be made in unit pack. The hard copy of price schedule must be signed and sealed (Full signature of competent person of the firm with mercantile seal) in each page by the tenderer.
- 4.3 The Cover 'B' should contain the price schedule duly signed and stamped properly filled in price column both in figures and words. If any discrepancy found between figure and words, the price mentioned in form of word will be considered as final price.
- 4.4 The "Cover 'B'" of only those tenderers who qualify in technical bid evaluation will be opened at the Office of the Superintendent. SCB MCH, Cuttack in the presence of the tenderers or their authorised representatives if they like so. **(Only one authorized person is allowed to attend the meeting for each firm with authorization letter from the firm specially authorized to attend the said meeting).** The date & time to this effect will be taken up as per schedule.
- 4.5 Any overwriting/ correction which shall be signed by the tenderer.
- 4.6 **The tenderer must submit the MS-Excel format of price bid (Annexure-II) in a CD-ROM/Pen Drive without changing our serial number.**
- 4.7 No extra column/row is allowed to insert/delete in the item list (price format) of excel sheet.



NON-RESPONSIVE/ REJECTION CRITERIA

5. The tender paper will be rejected if any of the following documents are wanting/not submitted: -
- i. Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 8,00,000/- (Eight Lakh Rupees) only in shape of Demand Draft from any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack payable at Cuttack.
 - ii. Bid Documents are not signed and sealed (Full signature of competent person of the firm with mercantile seal.) properly by the competent person/tenderer.
 - iii. Attested photocopies of up-to-date valid manufacturing license with drug endorsement copy in case the tenderer is a manufacturer.
 - iv. Duly attested valid up-to-date Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) certificate of the manufacturer as per the revised Schedule M of Drugs & Cosmetics Act 1940 / WHO GMP certificate from the licensing authority (In case the tenderer is a manufacturer and quotes for medicinal products only).
 - v. Non-conviction Certificate (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)) of the Manufacturer.
 - vi. Valid Market Standing Certificate for last 5 years from the competent authority of the manufacturer.
 - vii. Valid and up-to-date ISO Certificate of the Manufacturer.
 - viii. Valid CE certificate of the manufacturer (applicable for medical consumables).
 - ix. Price Bid/quoted rates (hard copy) with signature and seal of the tenderer. (Annexure - II) along with soft copy in excel format.
 - x. GST Registration Certificate registered under OGST act issued by competent authority of the manufacturer / distributor.
 - xi. Proof of Annual turnover of Rs.10 Crore or more for each financial year during last 5 financial years i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 duly certified by Chartered Accountant for the Manufacturer. (Annexure -VI) **(Not applicable for SSI Units registered under Govt. of Odisha).**
 - xii. Copy of last 5 financial years IT return (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) & PAN Card of the manufacturer if the bidder is a manufacturer.
 - xiii. GSTR 3B on monthly basis for one year (2024-25).
 - xiv. If the tenderer is a distributor, he/she has to submit, valid Drug License, ISO Certificate, Registration Certificate (Commercial Establishment) under Directorate of Labour, Odisha issued by the Inspector of Shops & Commercial Establishment. Trade License issued by competent Authority for Corporate Office as well as Local Branch Office (Govt. of Odisha), Non-Conviction Certificate of his/her own firm (Certificate must be issued within one year from the date of opening of tender (Technical bid)), PAN Card, IT Return for last 5 financial Year (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24), last 5 years Annual Turnover of Rs. 10 Crore or more for each financial year duly certified by a Chartered Accountant with annual audited statement / Annual Report & GST Registration Certificate issued by competent authority, GSTR on monthly basis for last one year (2024-25) of his/her firm.
 - xv. The Tenderer should have typically not less than 5 (five) years of marketing experience in Medicine/ pharmaceuticals products supplying


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to the Government Organization/ PSU Hospitals in India duly supported documentary evidence ((5 (five) no's of Purchase Order copies for each financial year duly attested by Notary Public) from minimum 5 (five) competent Authorities & End User Certificate from same 05 (Five) competent authorities for last five year i.e. (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) (Performance Statement (Annexure-VII)).

- xvi. Affidavit in respect to not been convicted under the provision of D&C Act 1940 by any court of law in contravention to the above Act & Rules & has not been blacklisted for any item either by the tender inviting authority or by any state Govt. Or Central Govt. Organization participate in the tender for those items during the period of blacklisting (Annexure-1)
- xvii. Deviation of any format given in the tender document will be liable to rejection of bid.

EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (BID SECURITY)

- 6.1 Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 8,00,000/- (Eight Lakh Rupees) only in shape of Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank drawn in favour Medical Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack payable at Cuttack.
- 6.2 The local micro, small & medium enterprises registered with respective DICs, Khadi, Village, Cottage & Handicraft Industries, OSIC & NSIC shall be exempted from payment of EMD subject to submission of the valid registration certificate & exemption certificate in proper format from the concerned authority.
- 6.3 In lieu of Bid Security with stipulation period, that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity etc., the bidder will be suspended for a period of 2 years for participating in the tender process before the tendering authority. The EMD submitted by the bidder will be forfeited.
- 6.4 EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be discharged/ returned after submission of request letter followed by finalisation of price bid.
- 6.5 No interest will be paid for the EMD submitted.


PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- 7.1 To ensure due performance of the contract, performance security is to be deposited by the successful bidders awarded the contract.
- 7.2 The performance security will be returned without interest after expiry of approved list (Contract period)/extended period if any/ completion of the quality testing or expiry of the last batch of drugs & medical consumables supplied whichever is later.

TENDER CONDITION

- 8.1 The quoted rate shall not vary with the quantum of order placed for destination points.
- 8.2 The price quoted by the tenderers shall not in any case, exceed the controlled price. The purchaser, at his discretion, will in such case, exercise the right of revising the price at any stage so as to confirm to the controlled price or MRP as the case may be.
- 8.3 A copy of the tender condition and the schedules should be signed by tenderer at the bottom of each page with the office seal duly affixed and submitted along with the tender in cover "A".
- 8.4 Tenders should be type-written or Computerized and every correction/over writing in the tender should invariably be attested with signature of the tenderer with date before submission of the tenders to the authorities concerned. No

- revision of price (upward or downward) will be allowed once the tender is opened.
- 8.5 Each tender format (price schedule) must contain the rate of each item which includes Excise Duty, Transportation (i.e door delivery), Insurance and all other charges etc. And excludes GST. The absolute rate should be quoted both in figure and word.
- 8.6 If there is a discrepancy between word and figure, the amount mentioned in word will prevail.
- 8.7 If there is discrepancy in absolute and unit rate (which is obtained by multiplying the absolute rate with the total number in a unit pack) **the absolute price will prevail and the unit price will be corrected accordingly.**
- 8.8 To ensure sustained supply without any interruption the Medical Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack reserves the right to split orders for supplying the requirement among more than one tenderer provided that, the rates and other conditions of supply are equal. In case of non-supply of any item by any approved lowest quoted firm, Medical Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack can ask for willingness to L2/L3/L4/L5 etc. Firm for supply at L1 rate (lowest approved rate) and procure the same item in L1 rate. The unit packing should be uniform as prescribed for each item.
- 8.9 **The rates quoted and accepted will be binding with the tenderer for a period of two years from the date of publication of the approved list that of publication of the next approved list whichever is earlier and on no account any increase in the price will be entertained till the completion of this tender period.**
- 8.10 No tenderer shall be allowed at any time on any ground whatsoever to claim revision or modification of the bid document including price quoted by him. Clerical error, typographical error etc. Committed by the tenderers in the tender forms will not be considered after opening of the tenders. Conditions such as **"SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY, SUPPLY WILL BE MADE AS AND WHEN SUPPLIES ARE RECEIVED"** etc. Will not be considered under any circumstance and the tenders of those who have given such condition shall be treated as incomplete and for that reason, shall be summarily rejected.
- 8.11 If at any time during the period of contract, the price of the tendered items is reduced or brought down by any law or act of the Central or State Govt. Or by the tenderer himself, the tenderer shall be morally and statutorily bound to inform the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack immediately about such reduction in the contracted prices. The Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack is empowered to unilaterally effect such reduction as is necessary in rates in case the tenderer fails to notify or fails to agree for such reduction of rates. In case of any enhancement in Tax due to statutory Act of the Govt. After the date of submission of the tenders and during the tender period, the additional Tax so levied will be allowed to be charged extra as separate item without any change in price structure of the drugs approved under the tender. For claiming the additional cost on account of the increase in Tax, the tenderer should produce letter from the concerned Tax authorities indicating his commitment for the supply made to the Medical Superintendent, SCB MCH, Cuttack on account of the increase in Tax.
- 8.12 The Tax will be charged as per the guideline given by the Finance Deptt. From time to time. GST component should be shown separately in the cost price (Price Schedule) **(Annexure-II).**


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- 8.13 If the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack desires, he can extend the period of validity of approved list by mutual consent with due approval from Purchase Committee.
- 8.14 In the event of the date being declared as a holiday by Govt. Of Odisha, the due date of submission of bids and opening of bids will be the following working day at the appointed place & time.
- 8.15 The Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack reserves the rights to reject the tenders or to accept the tenders for the supplies to all items or any one or more of the items tendered for without assigning any reason.
- 8.16 The Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack will at liberty to terminate without assigning any reason there of the contract either wholly or in part. The tenderer will not be entitled for any compensation what so ever in respect of such termination.
- 8.17 If the L1 firm fails to execute the supply within the stipulated time, the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack is empowered to purchase from L2,L3,L4,&L5 firm at L1 rate or make emergency purchase from local market as per financial guideline to meet crisis.
- 8.18 The quantity of procurement may increase or decrease depending on the budget provisions, new scheme, natural calamities and epidemics etc.
- 8.19 **The tenderer has to accept all the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender documents. The tenderer must clarify his doubt/query on the bid during Pre-bid conference any further complain after bid opening will not be entertained and decision of the committee is final.**
- 8.20 **The tender document is not transferable.**
- 8.21 The price bid offer by the bidders must remain valid for minimum 180 days (six months) from the date of opening of technical bid to price bid opening.
- 8.22 With reference to the clause no. 8.21(Tender condition), any violation leads to non-responsive/ rejection of bid by the Tender inviting authority.
- 8.23 The bidder can't withdraw their bid within the bid validity period.

SUPPLY CONDITIONS

- 9.1 The supplier/firm will supply as per the technical specification and print the generic name in bold letters and brand name if approved by the licensing authority may be printed in small front in strip/bottle/injection/packing/foil/carton/packet/ box etc.
- 9.2 The tenderer should deliver the Drugs & Medical Consumables at the consignee (Door Delivery) at Sub-store, DHH, Cuttack. The insurance, storage & transport charges/courier charges if any will be borne by the supplier. The short supply, damage if any at the time of delivery of consignment shall be replaced by the supplier within seven days from date of supply on indented items.
- 9.3 If the supplier is a distributor, he/she has to submit the Valid ISO Certificate, valid GMP or WHO-GMP certificate of the manufacturer(s), valid CE certificate of the manufacturer (applicable for medical consumables) at the time of supply of each product.
- 9.4 In all the cases the responsibility of the purchaser will start only after delivery and due verification of goods.
- 9.5 The Composition & strength of each item tendered should be as per the specification given in (Technical Specification) item list.
- 9.6 The supply should be started immediately & completed within 60 days from the date of issue of the purchase order. If supply is not completed within 60 days from the date of issue of purchase order, the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack may cancel



the order or allow extension. The Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack has also liberty to cancel those orders and purchase the same items from L2, L3, L4 & L5 firms as the case may be if the other firms agree to supply at L1 rate. The ~~Suptd. SCB MCH~~ Cuttack can reduce the time span of the supply period in case of natural calamities/ pandemic/ in any type of emergency or similar circumstances noticed in the district.

- 9.7 **Each instalment and batch of supply of drugs must be accompanied with an analytical test certificate that the supplied medicines are of standard quality and as per the standard of IP/BP/USP etc..**
- 9.8 **The Drugs and Medical Consumables should arrive at the destination (Sub-Store) with remaining shelf-life of at least 5/6th of the stipulated total shelf-life from the date of manufacturing of that product.** However, the acceptance authorities may accept those products being not complying the above condition for ensuring the order quantity is minimal in nature, non-availability, any natural calamity, epidemic/ pandemic with an undertaking from the supplier that "The supplier will replace the unutilised product if not consumed within its self-life or expiry".
- 9.9 The labels in case of injectable should be clearly indicate whether the preparations are meant for INTRA VENOUS, INTRA-MUSCULAR or SUBCUTANEOUS or INTRADERMAL etc.
- 9.10 The packing cartons must bear the name of the items, strength, total quantity, name of the manufacturer, month of manufacturing and month of expiry.
- 9.11 Each Strip/Box/Carton/Bottle/Amp/Vial/ Packet shall bear name of the manufacturer and month of manufacturing, month of expiry & Batch No/Lot No.

QUALITY TESTING

- 10.1 **All the suppliers/ manufacturers must submit Analytical test report from In-house /any approved laboratory of the batches being supplied to the consignee.**
- 10.2 The district will also do random testing of the supplied drugs if required for which quality testing, packing and forwarding charges if any will be borne by the supplier @ 2% of the Purchase Order.
- 10.3 If the Drugs and Medical Consumables as per report is found not of standard quality in first test, the supplier will be required to replace the entire quantity of the batch declared NSQ or the cost of it in shape of bank draft in favour of Superintendent, SCBMCH, Cuttack payable at Cuttack & take back the available stock (unused) in different health institutions of Cuttack district at his own cost within a period of 30 days of receipt of letter from Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack.
- 10.4 If the supplier does not take back the NSQ stocks or does not challenge the 1st test report within 30 days of issue of letter by the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack, the concerned health institution can destroy the NSQ declared stocks as per the guideline.
- 10.5 If the items have been tested by the D.I & the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack, the NSQ report of either of the authority will be accepted & action will be taken accordingly, if the supplier challenges the test report in the above circumstances, then it will go for testing to State Drugs Testing Laboratory/Central Drugs Testing Laboratory, whose report will be final. The packaging, transportation and testing charges etc. Will be borne by the supplier.



- 10.6 The supplier shall be responsible for the full replacement in his own cost for any product, if the same is found on visual inspection to have deteriorated/ not of standard quality before the expiry date.
- 10.7 The Tender Inviting Authority's contractual right to inspect, test and, if necessary, reject the goods after the goods' arrival at the final destination shall have no bearing of the fact that the goods have previously been inspected and cleared by Tender Inviting Authority's inspector during sample verification as mentioned above.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 11 No advance payment towards cost of Drugs & Medical Consumables etc. Will be made to the supplier. The supplier has to submit 3 (three) copies of the bills/ invoices with a photocopy of the purchase order at the time & place of supply for stock entry. No claims shall be made against the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack in respect of interest on EMD, Performance Security or delayed payment.

PENALTIES

- 12.1 If the tenderer withdraws or alters its bid or unwilling to accept the terms and conditions of the tender after submission of bid & during the bid validity period (180 days), The EMD submitted by the bidder will be forfeited.
- 12.2 If the successful tenderer fails to execute the work order/ replacement of NSQ stock within the time specified/unable to undertake the contract or supply as per purchase order, his purchase order will be cancelled. He will also be liable for the damages sustained by the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack, such damages shall be assessed by the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack, whose decision will be final in the matter. The Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack can forfeit the performance security of the defaulting firms and de-recognise / black list the said firm for 2 (two) years from the date of issue of letter. The entire forfeited amount may be deposited in the Account of the Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack and can be utilized for procurement of essential Drugs & Medical consumables.
- 12.3 If any Drugs & Medical Consumables supplied by the tenderer being partially used or consumed after supply and are subsequently found to be in bad order, unsound, inferior in quality or description or otherwise faulty or unfit for consumption, the supplier will be required to replace the entire quantity of that item or the cost of it in shape of bank draft in favour of Suptd. SCB MCH, Cuttack & take back the available stock (unused) from Superintendent SCBMCH, Cuttack in his own cost within a period of 30 days of receipt of letter and if any deviation made by the firm will be de-recognized for 2 (two) years for that item from the date of issue of letter.
- 12.4 The tenderer can be blacklisted for a period of 3 years by the tender inviting authority in case it is found at the time of evaluation/ verification/ inspection that the tenderer has furnished forged documents/false information along with the tender.
- 12.5 In the event of any litigation arising out of tender such matters would be subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court, Orissa or Civil Courts of Cuttack


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LIQUIDATED DAMAGE:

- 13 The Superintendent, SCBMCH, Cuttack may allow extension on request of the firm for a maximum period of 28 days, after the stipulated date of supply, i.e. 60 days from the issue of purchase order, with the penalty of 1% of purchase order value as "Liquidated Damage", for each week upto a maximum of 4% on the value of the goods. So, the firm has to supply drugs and other consumables without penalty upto 60 days and with penalty of 1% each week for the delayed supplies upto a maximum of 4%.

CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO SSI UNITS OF THE STATE:

14. The SSI Units of the State of Odisha will be eligible to participate in the tenders and get the price preference provided they produce the attested photocopy of the following documents:

- A. Local Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises and Khadi & Village industrial units including coir, handloom and handicrafts will be entitled for a price preference of 10% in comparison with local Medium and Large Industries and Industries outside the State (Odisha).
- B. Any local micro & small enterprises having valid ISO / ISI certification for their product will get an additional price preference of 3%.
- C. The local micro, small & medium enterprises registered with respective DICs, Khadi, Village, Cottage & Handicraft Industries, OSIC & NSIC shall be exempted from payment of EMD and shall pay 25% of the prescribed performance security.
- D. Freight Charges will be paid to the Local SSI units registered under Director of Industries, Odisha or General Manager District Industries Centre after production of cash memo/bill.
18. The supplies will be delivered by the approved SSI Units at the destination points as mentioned.
19. All the criteria mentioned under Eligibility Criteria except 2.2 & 2.3 are applicable for SSI Units.
