The last date of receipt of tender paper will be Dt. **22.09.2025** by 5.00 PM from the date of publication in newspaper and be opened on the next working day at 3.30 PM in the office chamber of Dean and Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack. The bidders may download the Tender document containing the details of term and condition directly from this college's website available at <http://scbmch.in> and also can be obtained on all working days from the Budget section of office of the Dean and Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack by depositing cost of tender paper for Rs. 1000/- (Nonrefundable) in shape of demand draft in favour of **"Dean and Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack"** payable at Cuttack from any Nationalized Bank. Any tender received after the due date & time will be rejected and returned to the sender un-opened. The Tender will be received through Regd. Post/Speed Post only. TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Reputed Book Publishers/Authorised suppliers having experience in supplying medical books and Journals can participate in this tender process.
2. That supplier must quote price for at least 90% of the books listed in the tender. This ensures that suppliers are providing comprehensive quotes and not cherry-picking certain titles.
3. Tender Documents can be obtained from the office of Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack on any working day from 10.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. on payment of Rs. 1000 /- (Non refundable) or can be download from the SCB Medical College Website <http://scbmch.in>.
4. The Tenderers should submit their tenders in a sealed cover, addressed to the **Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack-753007, Odisha** and the corresponding postal address of the tenders should also be mentioned on the cover of the sealed tender. Each tender must enclose the copy of money receipt in support of purchase of tender paper or a Bank Draft of Rs.1000.00, when the tender form would be downloaded from the website as the case may be. The DD is to drawn in favour of Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack within the stipulated date & time. The sealed tender will be received by the undersigned on or before **22.09.2025 up to 5.00 PM** and will be opened on **dt.23.09.2025 at 3.30 PM** in presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who should be present at the place as per scheduled date and time. If the tenderers or their authorized representatives fail to turn-up at the time of opening of the tenders, it will not be bar for the authority to open the tender. Tender received beyond the scheduled date and time will not be taken into consideration and will be rejected. Any deviation in the scheduled date of opening of the tender will be intimated to the tenderers through their postal address/e mail given by them on the cover of the sealed tender.
5. The tenderers should furnish the Xerox copy of PAN Card along with their tenders.
6. Publisher's Price:-
 - a. Percentage of discount on the publisher's price of medical books/journals should be quoted very clearly against each book and journal.
 - b. The publisher's price of the books/journals, percentage of discount and discounted price of each journal should be quoted very clearly in INR of each book and journal.
7. Delivery of books and journals should be made at the central library of SCB Medical College, Cuttack within the stipulated time.
8. The Tenderers should supply of Medical Books/Journals within 21 days from the date of purchase order. Order for supply of books/journals will be placed time to time as per requirement of students and doctors. Order placed for supply of books/journals will be treated as cancelled if not supplied within the stipulated period when so will be decided by the authority/authorized committee.
9. Tender is valid up to one year.
10. No advance payment will be made for supply of books. But advance payment may be made only for journals on the basis of agreement against bank guarantee (vide para19 & 20).

1. Payment of the cost of books will be made only after full receipt of books as per order, verification of price and edition of the books received with the publisher's prevailing price and edition.
12. The communications and documents are to be clearly written in English and the discounted rates mentioned by the bidder should be clearly visible. On the top of the sealed cover it should be super scribed as "TENDER FOR 'BOOKS'OR'JOURNALS', SCB. MEDICAL COLLEGE, CENTRAL LIBRARY FOR THE FY 2025-2026".
13. The payment of the cost of foreign edited/ published books will be made on the basis of exchange rate as declared by the appropriate authority or on the basic of exchange rate for library purchase as declared by Government of India whichever will be less as on the date of supply of books/journals to the library in INR. The certificate in support of exchange rate must be enclosed with each bill Advance payment against journals will be final as per the claim made in the tender and no further charge or supplementary demand will be entertained during the financial year 2025-26.
14. If the information or document furnished by the tenderer with the tender paper is found to be misleading, haphazard or incorrect at any stage, the tender will be cancelled.
15. The selected supplier will sign an agreement in non-judicial stamp paper with the Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack for acceptance of terms & conditions.
16. The tenderer selected for supply of books must supply all required/ order placed books (available in India), otherwise the supplier will be blacklisted.
17. The authority/committee reserves the right to accept in full or part or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof. The authority/committee is not bound to accept the lowest rates of tenders. The technical aspects will be taken in to consideration.
18. Books and journals supplied should be in original print and of latest edition. If there in anticipation of release of new edition of books within the current year, the supplier should intimate the authority regarding this, instead of supplying the available edition & will undertake to supply as soon as the same made available before the bill payment. Journals should be supplied within 30 days from the date of original publication. The old edition will not be acceptable if the recent edition is expected near future.
19. The tenderer shall furnish the following documents along with the tender which are to be reflected in the forwarding letter.
 - a. The demand draft towards the cost of the tender paper to be submitted in technical bid.
 - b. Photocopy of the PAN Card.
 - c. Declaration to supply the journals regularly.
 - d. Declaration of discount on medical books and undertaking for total supply in time.
 - e. Declaration that 90% of books listed in the tender quoted.
 - f. Photocopy of previous purchase orders from Govt. Medical College of Odisha if any
 - g. The bidder should submit **EMD** amounting to Rs.1,35,000/- for Books and Rs.1,70,000/-for Journals in shape of D.D. payable at Cuttack pledged in favour of the **"Dean & Principal, SCB Medical College, Cuttack."**
 - h. GST Registration Certificate.
 - i. Income Tax return for last 2 years with PAN Number.
 - j. The company has to be in existence for at least 10 years. Registration Certificate must be submitted as proof.
 - k. Has to be a Member of good office's Committee/The Federation of Publishers & Bookseller's Association of India for at least 10 years (proof to be enclosed).

- l. RBI permission: The supplier must have permission from RBI to open foreign currency bank accounts specially for journals subscriptions, such permission must be attached.
 - m. The company should have a minimum turnover 5 Crores per annum. Balance Sheet of last 3 years must be submitted as proof.
 - n. In case of Journal the company should have executed at least 10 subscriptions order worth Rs. 50 Lakh each or more in the last year. In case of books, the company should have supplied to at least two Medical Colleges/ Medical Institution, worth Rs. 10 lakh each or more per year. Order copies and money receipt should be attached as proof.
 - o. The Company's executive should visit to reconcile supply status at least once in a month.
 - p. The Company should have an internet/web based facility where supply, claim & delivery status can be viewed online. If yes, at least 5 working examples on a CD to be submitted.
 - q. The firm must submit the self-declaration certificate of availability of all books as per the advertisement in the tender.
20. The **EMD** of successful bidder will be refunded after one year of successful completion of procurement work. However the **EMD** of unsuccessful bidders would be returned back soon after the completion of tender process.
 21. The list of books/journals are enclosed herewith in separate pages.
 22. The supplier of books will have to certify on the face of bill regarding supply of latest edition books and correct publisher's price. The authority reserves the right to ask the supplier to provide authentic proof in this regard.
 23. The bidders there who have been black listed by any of the organisation/purchaser/publisher then their bids/offers will not be entertained and be rejected.
 24. "Subscribed agent of the Publisher" certificate will be verified from the publisher before opening the financial bid.
 25. After getting the purchase order the vendor will have to submit remittance proof and acknowledgement from the publisher.
 26. A Bank guarantee of an amount equal to the amount claimed in advance payment must be submitted by the successful bidder for journals before getting the purchase order. The guarantee period will be for a period of 2 years and 3 months (for journals) of the agreement for successful bidders.
 27. The authority will carry no responsibility for receipt of the tender paper beyond the stipulated last date for submission due to postal delay.
 28. All the documents for technical bid are to be kept in a sealed envelope marked '**Envelope A**'. The **EMD** amount is not to be disclosed and the DD in this regard is to be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope and kept inside envelope A. The price bid document is to be kept in another sealed envelope marked as '**Envelope B**'. Both envelope A & envelope B are to be kept in another sealed envelope-marked as '**Envelope C**'. The Envelope C is to be super scripted as "TENDER FOR BOOKS OR JOURNALS OR E-JOURNALS, SCB MEDICAL COLLEGE LIBRARY FOR THE FY 2025-26."
